Industrial style

Joining the Innov8 collection is this framed fixed bath screen, which features 8mm thick glass and a matt black industrial finish, sand-blasted for extra durability and scratch resistance. The screen is 1,500mm high with an adjustment of 785mm to 800mm and different brace bar options available, including back to wall or straight to ceiling. Shown here with fluted glass, which offers a degree of privacy without reducing the light, it also comes with clear glass. Boxed in

Affordable elegance
